Brilliant dark red with purple reflections. Aromas of black plum, bergamot and violet married with vanilla, and cocoa on the palate. Full in the mouth with plenty of character and silky tannins

Vibrant violet colour. Exotic notes reminiscent of cinnamon, nutmeg on the palate, mature fruit, round and smooth retaining good body.

**184. 2020 Royal Road Cabernet Sauvignon, Mendoza Argentina** £6 £8

Bags of fruit on the nose, cassis and blackberry dominate with a touch of vanilla

**207. 2017. Rede Reserva, Douro doc, Tinta Roriz- Portugal** £7 £9

Deep red colour, aged in oak, a fine blend of distinctive Portugues grapes delivering, lingering ripe fruit balanced well with the oak aging.

Made from selected organic grapes. Brilliant red with purple tints, beguiling black cherries on the nose, sweet dark forest fruits on the palate, fine and focused with an expressive finish.

**206. 2017 Chateau Picon Bordeaux superieur, France** £12 £15.5

Opulent, deep dark red in colour, powerful on the pallet with dense tannings with a hint of vanilla

**1. House, Chaudron Grande Reserve, France - Brut**

£58

Clear gold colour with fine bubbles. Aromas of lemon and hazelnuts revealing on the palate. Smooth and velvety sensations.

**2. House, Chaudron, France - Rose**

£60

Delicate pale pink colour. Aromas of red fruits such as strawberries and raspberries. Tingling bubbles underlining the freshness with good length.

**3. 2012 Chaudron, Blanc de Blanc, Vintage, France – Brut**

£70

Fresh, supple and soft fine flavours of white peach and grapefruit prolong the enchantment.

**4. Veuve Clicquot, Yellow Label, Reims, France – Brut**

£74

A brilliant colour with yellow tints. Fine mousse with a lychee fruit and floral nose.

**5. Laurent Perrier, Tours-sur-Marne, France – Rose**

£95

Light golden with a crispy quince nose, rich white berry flavours and a delightful lemon finish.

**6. Bollinger Special Cuvée, Ay, France – Brut**

£80

Deep golden in colour with very fine bubbles giving way to complex aromas of ripe fruits, hints of roasted apples, apple compote and peaches. A classic!

**7. 2012 Dom Perignon, Vintage, Epernay, France – Brut**

£199

The luminous sweetness of tropical fruit – green mango, melon, pineapple – instantly shines. It then cedes to more temperate notes, the tingle of orange zest, the mist of a mandarin orange.

**8. 2014 Louis Roederer Cristal -France**

£255

Intense Golden hue with fine bubbles, candid citrus and toasted notes, followed by ripe fruit. Complemented with purity and freshness.

From the famous Bedin Treviso Estate. Silver green colour with enticing aromas of brioche and white raspberries. Exquisite, fine mousse with a long, elegant finish.

**21. Prosecco Colli Asolandi di Bedin Teresa, Treviso, Italy – Rose**

£39

Selected Merlot and Pinot Noir grapes fuse into a delicate pink colour. Floral aromas, taste of pink berries with a fine perlage.

A light, silver, slightly biscuity on the nose, refreshing, clean and creamy with a delicious fragrant dry finish.

Light pink colour, aromas of fresh strawberry with plenty of flavour soft, drinking superbly, with a delicious finish edging into woodland fruit.

**32. Chateau des Vingtineres, Provence, France – Rolle/Grenache**

£36

Pale rose colour. The bouquet expresses a typicality of Provence, intense early spring flowers, peaches and apricots. Plenty of charm. A softly dry exquisite finish.

**33. Domaine Chavet et Fils, Menetou-Salon, Loire, France – Pinot Noir**

£50

Very clear bright light salmon pink colour, characteristic aroma of pinot noir with floral and fruity shades. Delicately dry and a refreshing taste of young rose hips at the end. A must!

New World Winery of the Year 2015 Award - Wine Enthusiast. Beautiful light gold colour.  
Tropical notes of melon and papaya with a delicious peach flavour and a hint of hazelnut on the finish

**41. La Domaine La Grange, Languedoc-Roussillon, France – Viognier** *£33*  
Light brilliant yellow with green tints, dry fruits and floral aromas fresh mellow peach on the palate with a long persistent finish.

**42. Haindl Erlacher, Stixenkreuter, Weinviertel, Austria – Gruner Veltliner** *£36*  
An attractive silver with a touch of green colour. The citrusy, tangy aromatic bouquet is the key, to this wine. Dry with a subtle sweetness in the middle on the palate, vivacious and crisp.

**43. Gavi, Piemonte, Italy – Cortese** *£40*  
From a Cru region within the Gavi in the Ligurian Hills. Italy's finest white from the prestigious Northwest region. Internationally recognised and acclaimed by wine critics.

**44. Domaine Vocoret, St. Valentin, Chablis, France – Chardonnay** *£60*  
Luminescent gold with gentle stone and citrus fruits on the nose. Vivid palate of limestone, minerality, finishing with an uplifting sensation.

Single Vineyard. Silvery gold colour. Aromas of white apricot blossoms.  
A limey palate, mouth-filling, dry and crispy.

Lemon gold colour, honeydew aroma, ripe apricots and white peach taste, creamy full texture, expressive and balanced.

**52. Casa do Capitaio-Mor, Vinho Verde, Portugal – Alvarinho** *£40*  
Crystal clear. Light citrus, intense aromas of limes, flowers and pineapple, slight touch of hazelnut. Fresh on the palate and crisp with soft weight and lengthy finish.

**53. Les Charmes, Pouilly-Fume, Loire, France – Sauvignon Blanc** *£49*  
A clear yellow hue with green highlights. Expressive nose of citrus and blackcurrant leaf, a touch of flint, generous and abundant on the finish.

**55. Domaine Roland Tissier, Sancerre, Loire, France – Sauvignon Blanc** *£55*  
Magnificent harvest. Golden-green with aromas of pear. Hints of tropical fruits on the palate. Plenty of minerality with a full finish and a touch of pineapple.

**60. Santa Catharina, Valle Central Chile – House Sauvignon Blanc** *£37*  
Citrusy and white fruits aromas, very fresh on the palate with a fruity aromatic flavour and a good finish on exotic flavours.

**61. Piquepoul Les Roche Saintes, Languedoc-Roussillon, France** *£35*  
Very lively yellow, floral aromas, touch of citrus, fresh and lively flavours of white fruits with fruity crispness.

**62. Spy Valley, Sauvignon Blanc – Marlborough New Zealand** *£41*  
Pure and vibrant with layers of passionfruit, tropical fruit and zesty citrus. Juicy fruit flavours and crisp acidity combine to deliver a mouth-watering finish.

**63. Domaine Haas, Grand Cru Schlossberg, Alsace, France – Gewurztraminer** *£58*  
Light gold with intense aromas of flowers and spices. Beautifully fruity with a slightly smoky taste. Aromatic and full in the mouth.

Gleaming gold showing aromas of peach and lemon. Rich wine bursting with lime fruits, supple and ample on the palate.

- 70. Pierre Ferraud, L'Entreroches, Pouilly-Fuisse, France – Chardonnay** £79  
Limpid golden robe with greenish glints, expressive aromas of brioche and orange blossom. Yellow fruits on the palate, rich juicy and exotic with plenty of substance.
- 71. Les Grechons, Ladoix Premier Cru, France – Chardonnay** £96  
Light gold colour, aromas of exotic chardonnay, floral and acacia, creamy sensation of pears on the palate, full and fresh.
- 72. Vincent Bouzereau, Meursault, France – Chardonnay** £100  
Glowing golden yellow. A bouquet of charming peach. The palate has a minerality combined with layers of crushed roasted almonds. A rich, endless and charming finish.
- 73. L'Elegance, Puligny Montrachet, France – Chardonnay** £145  
Bright gold colour with greenish highlights. The bouquet brings together hawthorn blossoms, ripe grapes, marzipan, hazelnut, amber, lemongrass and green apple. Graceful
- 74. La Maltroie, Chassagne Montrachet Premier Cru, France – Chardonnay** £150  
Citrus and minerals on the nose, a great intensity and a full body deriving from the clay-based soils. Candied apricot, tangerine and ripe fruit flavours converge with minerality on the structured palate.

This has a plump edge, with brioche notes wrapped around a core of citrus oil, grapefruit pulp and white peach. A smoky hint weaves through the creamy finish. Alluring
- 81. Montee de Tonnerre, Chablis Premier Cru, France – Chardonnay** £84  
A pale golden colour, with a delicate bouquet of pears and apples. Generous and rich flowery flavours, long in the mouth. A fantastic expression of Chablis!
- 82. Les Folatieres, Puligny Montrachet Premier Cru, France – Chardonnay** £198  
Brilliant shiny gold robe. Bouquet of lemongrass with smoky notes. Expressive limestone on the palate, well defined, bursting with energy. Wonderfully polished
- 83. Goutte d'Or, Meursault Premier Cru, France – Chardonnay** £185  
Tiny vineyard. Beautiful yellow colour with golden reflections. Aromas of white pears and baked brioche. Clear juicy white peaches on the palate with a fresh long aftertaste.

- 90. 2017 Pierre Ferraud, Le Reposoir, Fleurie, Beaujolais, France – Gamay** £46  
Brilliant red colour. Floral with notes of banana skin. Displays a good balance of lingering crushed, red fruits on the palate with a mouthwatering finish.
- 91. 2018 Pierre Ferraud, Moulin a Vent, Bourgogne, France – Gamay** £49  
Classic, red fruit and fresh on a nose of sweet cherry and redcurrant married to new oak. Generous, the ending is gracious with final notes of red fruit and vanilla.
- 92. 2018 Morello di Scansano, Poggioraso, Tuscany, Italy – Cabernet Franc** £90  
This wine is fresh and pleasant with notes of red fruit. Excellent as an aperitif if served chilled.

- 100. 2019 Santa Carolina Reserva, Colchapaol Valley, Chile – House Merlot** *£32*  
Vibrant violet colour. Exotic notes reminiscent of cinnamon, nutmeg on the palate, mature fruit, round and smooth retaining good body.
- 101. Quinta das Camélias Reserva, Dao, Portugal – Touriga Nacional** *£33*  
Brilliant dark red with purple reflections. Aromas of black plum, bergamot and violet married with vanilla, and cocoa on the palate. Full in the mouth with plenty of character and silky tannins.
- 102. Villa Motteria, Stilo, Puglia, Italy – Primitivo** *£48*  
Deep red colour, aromas of condensed red fruits, taste of black Morello cherries, walnut and carob. Velvety, harmonious fruity and full bodied.
- 103. Domaine de L’Harmas, Chateaufeuf du Pape, Rhone, France – Grenache** *£75*  
Deep colour aromas of dark berry fruits and plum. Silky in texture with a hint of savoury black pepper spice with a beautiful mineral finish.
- 104. 2013 Maratray Dubreuil, Cote de Beaune, France – Pinot Noir** *£95*  
Purple red colour aromas of black fruit, taste of preserved fruits, truffle with a dark chocolate finish. A young but stunning example of French pinot noir.

Deep red, purple colour nose of red plum and Morello cherries combined with floral notes such as violets, hints of vanilla, chocolate and caramel, velvety and silky structure.
- 111. Jean Prieur, Du Plevaux, Western Cape, South Africa – Pinotage** *£34*  
Brilliant dark red with purple reflections. Aromas of black plum, bergamot and violet married with vanilla, and cocoa on the palate. Full in the mouth with plenty of character and silky tannins
- 112. Villa Motteria, Rosone Salento, Puglia, Italy – Negroamaro** *£49*  
Deep red colour, dark berry fruits, plenty of layers of chocolate and toffee with a hint of smoky tobacco on the finish. Velvety and harmoniums in the mouth.
- 113. Chalice Bridge, Margaret River, Australia – Shiraz** *£63*  
Dark, glittering red, ‘fig jam’ unoaked peppers with cloves, allspice and cinnamon, taste of red berry developing into a rich flavour.

- 120. 2011 Biurko Gorri, Gran Reserva, Rioja, Spain – Tempranillo** *£53*  
Made from selected organic grapes. Brilliant red with purple tints, beguiling black cherries on the nose, sweet dark forest fruits on the palate, fine and focused with an expressive finish.
- 121. 2015 Finca el Origen, Gran Reserve, Uco Valley, Argentina – Malbec** *£63*  
A premium Malbec. Deep red purple with black tints, aromas of morello cherries and perfume wildflowers harmonising on the palate. Subtle suggestion of roasted caramel at the finish.
- 122. 2016 Brunelli Amarone, Verona, Italy – Corvina/Rondinella/Corvinone** *£96*  
Red-violet colour. Nose of redcurrants and blueberries. Warming sensation of cherries with a hint of vanilla on the palate. Good balance and great elegance.



**123. 2006 Chateau Lacoste Borie, Pauillac, Bordeaux, France – Claret Blend** £159

A great second wine to drink. Deep red with reflective black tints. Wonderfully rich and crammed with dark berry fruits, classic vanilla oak infused. Brilliantly complex, a wine guaranteed to wow.

**124. 2005 Chateau du Domaine de L'Eglise, Pomerol, France – Merlot** £159

Displays a dark ruby colour, big, sweet aromas of melted liquorice, plenty of chocolate, mocha and plums. Deep and pure opulence, a beautiful wine.

**125. 2005 Chateau Saint Pierre, 4eme, St Julien, France – Claret Blend** £240

One of the properties of Henri Martin of Château Gloria. Old vines, reddish black, perfumed chalky fruit, crunchy black wild fruits intermingle with violets. Lively with substance.

*Our Resident Red Selection***130. 2010 Chateau Pontac Lynch, Margaux, Bordeaux, France – Claret Blend** £95

Situated between Chateau Margaux and Chateau Palmer owned by Chateau Haut-Brion. Gleaming red, bouquet of wild strawberries, hint of pomegranate and dark fruit cocoa on the palate

**131. 2009 Chateau Grand Corbin, St Emilion, Bordeaux, France – Claret Blend** £99

Deep purple hued, shows aromas of blue and blackberry fruit, outstanding concentration of mature black cherries. Long finish and very accessible.

**132. 2018 Chicotot, Les Plantes Au Baron, Nuits St George, France – Pinot Noir** £110

Purple red colour aromas of black fruit, taste of preserved fruits, truffle with a dark chocolate finish. A young but stunning example of French pinot noir

**133. 2018 David Duband, Gevrey Chambertin, Cote de Nuits – Pinot Noir** £150

Concentrated red fruit on the nose, hint of tobacco, supple fruity and airy in the mouth. Silky and refined oak with liquorice on the finish.

**134. 2009 Chateau Bataillry, 5eme, Pauillac, Bordeaux, France – Claret Blend** £155

Amazing with electric precision on the nose and palate. Gleaming red, nose of fine raspberry and blackberry mingling with minerality on the palate. A powerhouse and legendary Batailley. Glorious!

**135. 2014 Corton Clos du Roy, Grand Cru, Cote de Beaune, France – Pinot Noir** £165

Concentrated red fruit on the nose, hint of tobacco, supple fruity and airy in the mouth. Silky and refined oak with liquorice on the finish.

**136. 2010 Barolo Pio Cesare, Piemonte, Italy – Nebbiolo** £150

Exceptional Vintage. Textbook wine, Dark red aromas of plum and lavender followed by a crescendo of flavours crushed mineral liquorice on a centre palate of strawberry. A pure classic, Drinks till 2028

**137. 2006 Tenuta di Biserno, Il Pigno, Tuscany, Italy** £175

Intense black cherry colour. Ornellaia in its body has an amazing depth of flavour, reminiscent of blackcurrant, very soft on the finish. A wonderful Super Tuscan!

**138. 2006 Pavillon Rouge du Chateau Margaux, France – Claret Blend** £550

Bright ruby purple, voluptuous nose of cassis violets and blackberries which define themselves on the palate. Wonderful leafy freshness. The second wine of the grand vin Chateau Margaux

**139. 2009 Chateau Carruades de Lafite, Pauillac, Bordeaux – Claret Blend** £600

Swirling vermilion red, a violet perfume drifts out of the glass. Layer upon layer of exotic wild black fruits merging on a long memorable finish. The second wine of Chateau Lafite.

**140. 2010 Château Mouton Rothschild, 1er Cru Classe, Pauillac – Claret Blend** £750

Opulent and New World-like in its ripeness and expression with toasty oak underlying the flavours. Rich, full bodied and generous and offering quite an intense palate profile of blackberries and blackcurrant fruits.

## *Dessert Wines*

**160. 2016 Santa Carolina late Harvest, Rapel Valley, Chile – Sauvignon (50.0cl) £39**

Pale golden colour. Bouquet of white, orange blossom and dried apricot. The palate offers sweet nectarine and citrus peel with a refreshing tangy smooth ending.

**161. 2010 Chateau Carmes de Rieussec, Sauternes, Bordeaux – (37.5cl) £55**

Close to Yquem. Revealing a well bodied character, pale golden hue. Aromas of dried pears, apricot, pineapple and white almonds. Intense while remaining with a mineral freshness.

## *Magnums*

**170. 2010 Chateau Batailly, 5eme, Pauillac, Bordeaux, France – Claret Blend £250**

Deep purplish crimson, aromas of fruits of the forest, lovely texture, blackcurrant leaf on the palate. Very ripe finish.

**171. 2003 Le Bessole Amarone, Verona, Italy – Corvina/Rondinella/Corvinone £199**

This vintage is extraordinary. Deep red colour followed by an impressive bouquet of crushed blackcurrant, fresh dates and sweetness on the palate displaying freshness.

## *Halves*

**180. 2017 Ladoix Blanc Premier Cru, Burgundy, France – Chardonnay £48**

Bright lemon-yellow colour. Open nose of citrus and pear. The palate is full, an almost Chablis-like character. Hints of nutmeg and vanilla with refreshing minerality.

**181. 2015 Chateau Haute Nauve Grand Cru, St Emilion, France – Claret Blend £33**

Deep dark colour with violets hues. Aromas of cherries. Silky with plum fruit on the palate and a supple, smooth structure.

**182. 2015 Aloxe Corton, Cote de Beaune, France – Pinot Noir £46**

Bright red purple with bouquet of red fruits which captures the perfumed charm of sumptuous cherries with a sappy soft texture finish.
