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Sparkling Wines

Serre di Lago Prosecco DOC (Italy)

£38

This dry, light-bodied pale-yellow prosecco has a delicately fruity, slightly aromatic bouquet. It is nicely balanced, with flavours of citrus and floral.

Hambledon Classic Cuvée (England)

£55

England's Hambledon Classic Cuvée offers a refined palate with notes of citrus, green apple and brioche, balanced by vibrant acidity and a creamy mousse.

Rose Sparkling Wine

14.Di Maria Prosecco (Italy)

£42

Light rose colour, delicate and complex on the nose with peaches, green apple and citrus which follow into floral notes of rose and acacia. Perfect acidity and body on the palate.

Non-Alcoholic Sparkling

Copenhagen Organic Sparkling Tea (Denmark)

£42

A non-alcoholic sparkling tea with a complex flavor profile, combining the richness of black tea with the lightness of white teas. Hints of jasmine, berries, and citrus add depth, leading to a medium-dry finish.

Copenhagen Organic Rose Sparkling Tea (Denmark)

£42

This dry, non-alcoholic sparkling tea offers aromas of red berries, juicy apples, and hibiscus. It serves as an excellent alternative to sparkling rosé, delivering a rounded taste with a crisp finish.

Pinot Grigio Rose, Altino (Italy) A crisp, refreshing rosé that opens with subtle notes of strawberry and raspberry. Light and dry on the palate, it offers a touch of citrus and a lingering, fruity finish - an ideal companion for sunny summer days.	£35
Constance Cuvee (Provence/France) This wine is a pale pink color with luminous almost translucent quality. Its nose is fresh and fragrant, featuring notes of red berries and citrus zest. On the palate, it is crisp and balanced, delivering a harmonious blend of summer fruits and a clean, mineral finish.	£42
Coteaux D'Aix, AIX 2024 (Provence/ France) With a bright, pale pink color, this wine has a fruity, fresh nose with notes of ripe summer fruits. On the palate, it is delicately balanced with crisp acidity and soft, ripe fruit flavors, culminating in a smooth, lingering finish.	£60
Rose Et Or, Château Minuty (Provence/ France) Pale pink color with a luminous sheen. It offers complex aromas of citrus fruits, white flowers, and a hint of spice. On the palate, it is rich and elegant, with flavors of ripe peach, grapefruit, and a touch of minerality, leading to a long, satisfying finish.	£95
Cru Classe De Provence, Château Galoupet (Provence/ France) Light salmon pink, silver hues. Subtle notes of red forest berries, a hint of strawberries, peach and fresh orange zest, a mineral touch. Powerful, juicy, a refined fruit sweetness, ripe yellow apple, a well-integrated acidity, with a dark minerality	£110

Clos Mont Blanc (Spain) A balanced wine with citrus, green apple, and vanilla aromas, offering a medium body and refreshing acidity that gives it a smooth, rounded mouth feel.	£34
Chablis AOC Domaine Louis Moreau (Chablis/France) The nose of this wine showcases flinty, mineral aromas, with subtle tones of citrus and hints of buttery notes. This is contrasted by the lively palate, which is packed with lemony grapefruit flavours and culminates in a steely finish	£70
Pegasus Bay (Waipara Valley/New Zealand) Rich and reduced notes of lemon confit, gun smoke, river stones and grapefruit. The medium-bodied palate has a fine acidity and gives notes of orange blossom and honeysuckle.	£81
Hamilton Russell Vineyards (Hemel-En-Aarde, South Africa) Wonderful vibrant pear and lime fruit flavours and aroma, highlighted by a natural acidity and dry minerality	£85
Meursault 1er Cru, 2018 Bouchard Père et Fils, Genevrières (France) Very pale yellow/green. Delicate floral bouquet with hints of white blossom, fresh apple and minerality. Silky on the palate, but a bit soft at the core, pear fruit with caramel on the finish and moderately long.	£170
Chablis Grand Cru, 2011 Drohin Bougros (Burgundy/France) The pale-yellow colour is very pure, with light green reflections. On the nose, floral aromas of acacia harmonize with vegetal notes of fern and coriander. The aromas of fruit are enhanced by intense mineral notes evolving towards slightly smoky flavour.	£200
Chardonnay, Penfolds, Yattarna Bin 144 (Southern Australia) Pale lemon yellow. Smoky, apples, lemons, vanilla, citrus, fruit driven, intense nose, detailed. Fresh acidity, fruit driven, vanilla, apples, lemons, concentrated, detailed, layered, intense and long. Bit smoky.	£265



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White Wine (Sauvignon Blanc)

Matahiwi Estate (New Zealand)

£38

This vibrant and refreshing Sauvignon Blanc showcases a lively blend of lime, passionfruit, and gooseberry aromas, accented by a touch of minerality. A classic expression of the varietal with crisp style and elegance.

Sancerre Domaine Et Fils La Pierrier (Loire\France)

£50

The concentration that comes from lees aging is apparent in this ripe, textured wine. With its crisp apple character and touches of citrus, the wine is still vibrantly young.

Greywacke Wild (Marlborough/New Zealand)

£60

This Sauvignon Blanc reveals an aromatic bouquet of candied citrus peel, honeysuckle, brioche, and subtle herbal notes of tarragon and lemon thyme. The palate is generous and layered, offering vibrant citrus and stone fruit flavors, balanced by crisp acidity. A delicate smoky nuance and flinty minerality carry through to a long, dry, and elegant finish.

Pouilly Fume, Domaines Du Ladoucette (Loire/France)

£83

Fresh grassy, nettle, grapefruit, gooseberry, lees nose flecked with honey and green melon aromas. Ripe, dry and fresh on the palate with creamy acidity and more gooseberry, nettle, light artichoke, smoky, grassy, lemon/chalk flavours with a note of dried herbs.



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White Wine (Italy)

Pinot Grigio DOC, Rocca Vini (Veneto/Italy)

£35

An intense yellow coloured wine, showcasing a unique, fruity and intense bouquet. On the palate, this dry wine showcases a fresh, harmonious flavour.

Cortese, Gavi de Gavi, "Aulico" Cascina Radice (Piedmont/Italy)

£43

An intense yellow coloured wine, showcasing a unique, fruity and intense bouquet. On the palate, this dry wine showcased a fresh, harmonious flavour.

White Wine (France)

Picpoul De Pinet, Bellemare (Languedoc)

£41

Fresh and crisp with dominant citrus and mineral notes, this wine offers a clean and zesty finish that lingers, showing its vibrant character.

Marsanne/Rouselle, Saint-Joseph, M. Chapoutier "Les Granilites" (Rhone /France)

£80

Ripe, lush, round, and loaded with flowers, white peach, and tropical fruits, with just a touch of vanilla bean and spice in the nose and in the finish.

Viognier, Condreiu, 2011 E. Guigal (Rhone/France)

£114

Exotic aromas of citrus blossom and tropical fruit make a bold impression, followed up on the palate by ample weight and a touch of oiliness.



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White Wine (Rest of the World) Btl

Albarino” Pionaro”, Vina Almirante (Rias Baxias/Spain) £45

Delivers a vibrant and invigorating profile. Bursting with zesty citrus notes of lemon and lime, it also reveals delicate hints of white flowers and a touch of saline minerality. Crisp acidity and a long, clean finish.

Gruner Veltliner, Seifried Estate (Kampftel/Austria) £47

Our Seifried Nelson Gruner Veltliner offers delicate floral aromas and appealing notes of ground almond on the palate, with subtle hints of honeydew melon and chai. A clean, mineral finish runs through the length, leaving a lasting impression

Alvarinho, Mendes & Symington Contacto (Vinho Verde, Portugal) £52

Floral and delicate aroma, Contacto has a high aromatic concentration. The minerality turns it into an elegant and complex wine. Well-present citrus notes and complexity on the palate are the key to tasting this wine.

Reisling, Kilikanoon Morts Block (Clare Valley, Australia) £55

Tightly focused and elegant, this youthful Riesling offers a beautifully perfumed bouquet, with deep floral notes and a hint of crystalline purity. Aromas of lime juice, lemon, and green apple skin are layered with mineral and chalky undertones.



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Red wine (South America)

Merlot, Pictor (Central Valle, Chile)

£32

This dark violet wine showcases a pleasantly complex black fruit and cherry aromas, and is overflowing with ripe, sweet fruit flavours. The wine displays sticky tannins and culminates in an almost salty, herbal finish.

Malbec, Para Dos (Mendoza, Argentina)

£35

A perfumed, richly flavoured wine with blackberry and plum flavours with lighter notes of blueberry and a dry, yet fruity finish.

Pinot Noir, Gauchezco Vineyards (Mendoza, Argentina)

£38

The nose is delicate, with notes of strawberry, raspberry, and subtle floral hints. On the palate, it is light to medium-bodied, offering flavors of red berries with a touch of spice, supported by soft tannins and a smooth finish.

Malbec, Terrazas Grand (Las Compuertas, Argentina)

£85

Offers intense aromas of blackberry, plum, and hints of vanilla. On the palate, it is full-bodied, delivering flavors of ripe dark fruits, complemented by well-integrated oak notes, firm tannins, and a long, elegant finish.



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Red wine (Spain)

Tempranillo Blend, Rioja, Bodegas Altivo (Spain)

£34

The bouquet shows intense floral aromas, accented by fresh red and dark fruit notes and subtle tones of black liquorice. A fun, fruity wine, perfect for pairing with tomato and pasta dishes.

Tempranillo Blend, Rioja Gran Reserva, Marques De Murrietta (Spain)

£150

Deep garnet in colour with aromas of blackberry, black truffle, black olives and autumn leaves. On the palate expect lovely tannins and acidity complimented with orange peel and ripe red fruits of the forest.

Red wine (Italy)

Sangiovese Blend, Chianti, Barone Ricasoli Brolio (Italy)

£60

The nose has the piercing yet textured quality of black cherries, burnt sage, blood orange peel, flinty topsoil and wild mint. On the palate, wild strawberries emphasize the cherry and blood orange notes.

Valpolicella, Amarone, Tedeschi La Fabriseria (Italy)

£75

Aromas of aging—roasted notes, vanilla, and tobacco—intertwine beautifully with spirited red fruits like red currants, raspberries, and cherries. Subtle hints of honey and warm alcohol add depth, making this classic expression of Amarone.

Nebbiolo, Barberesco, Cerreto (Piedmont, Italy)

£105

It exudes complex aromas of rose petals, cherry, and hints of tobacco. The palate is elegant and structured, offering flavors of ripe red fruits, balanced acidity, and firm tannins, culminating in a long, persistent finish.

Aglianico Del Vulture Superiore, Paternoster Don Anselmo (Italy)

£115

The appearance shows a deep ruby red color, almost impenetrable and austere that of great wines. The nose expresses a broad and complex bouquet, characterized by unmistakable sulfur, currant, blueberry, cocoa, leather and sweet spices. The taste on the palate is warm, dry, with great structure and elegance.

Nebbiolo, 2010 Barolo Pio Cesare, (Piemonte, Italy)

£210

Exceptional Vintage. Textbook wine, Dark red aromas of plum and lavender followed by a crescendo



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of mineral liquorice on a central palate of strawberries. A pure classic, Drinks till 2028



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Red wine (Rest of the world)

Cabernet Sauvignon, Château Musar Jeune, (Bekaa Valley, Lebanon)

£60

A fascinating wine made with Cinsault, Syrah & Cabernet Sauvignon - showcasing aromas and flavours of blackberries, dark raspberry, red currants and barrel spices of clove and five spice. Taught, salivating, juicy and tasty on the palate. A wine of texture and mouthfeel as much as it is dark berries and red berry fruit flavours.

Pinotage, Southern Right (Hemel-en-Aarde, South Africa)

£52

This deep purple wine has complex aromas of red berries and cherries with hints of spice and earthy flavours of cocoa bursting with juicy berries on the palate that evolve into spice and earthy notes on the finish.

Touriga Nacional, Prats and Symingtons Post Scriptorum (Douro, Portugal)

£65

A well-rounded, balanced, and juicy red exhibiting notes of cherries, blueberries and dried herbs on the nose. It is medium-bodied with fine tannins. Driven and focused, with a velvety texture at the center and a flavorful finish of excellent length.

Shiraz, Mt Langi Cliff Edge (Victoria, Australia)

£70

A Shiraz of great intensity, purity and finesse with aromas of black and red berried fruits, vanilla, tar and baking spice through to a silky palate with a touch of mocha.

Pinot Noir, Jackson Family Wines La Crema Monterey (Sonoma Valley, USA)

£79

This medium bodied wine exudes aromas of tart cherry, rhubarb, and purple beetroot whilst on the palate you should expect red plum, cranberry, and boysenberry.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Xanadu (Margaret River, Western Australia)

£125

This deep purple wine offers a vibrant bouquet of blackcurrant, mulberries with a hint of earthy cocoa and bay leaf, the palate offers blue and black forest berries with dark cocoa and mint in the background.



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Red wine (France)

Gamay, Fleurie, Joseph Burrier (Beaujolais/France)

£55

This reveals a fine elegance due to the sandy granitic soils and expresses a mix of floral (peony, faded rose) and fruit (strawberry, blackcurrant) aromas. On the palate, the wine is well balanced with a delicate finish of smooth tannins. The wine evolution is perfect from 3 to 5 years.

Grenache, Crozes-Hermitage, M. Chapoutier Les Meysonniers (Rhone, France)

£65

Very intense purplish red colour with red fruits, blackcurrant and raspberry on the nose followed by violet aromas. Ample and round, final of stewed fruits and vanilla

Grenache, Chateau Neuf Du Pape, Les Granieres De La Nerthe (France)

£125

On the nose, aromas of blackcurrant and cherry are balanced by cinnamon and other sweet spices. on the palate, elegant flavours of cherry, accompanied by fine tannins and a refreshing, long finish.

Cabernet Franc, 2016 St Emillion Grand Cru, Annonce de Bélair Monage (France)

£150

This full-bodied merlot blend has red cherry, pomegranate, and wild raspberry on the nose with delivers succulent blackberry compote notes with medium tannin

Pinot Noir, 2015 Drouhin Clos de Vougeot Grand Cru (Burgundy/France)

£415

This medium-bodied pinot noir grown from the finest grand cru vineyards has dominated black fruit aroma with blueberries, blackcurrants, and figs. Very floral on the palate with racy tannins.

Claret Blend, 2006 Pavillon Rouge du Chateau Margaux, (France)

£550

Bright ruby purple, voluptuous nose of cassis violets and blackberries which define themselves on the palate. Wonderful leafy freshness. The second wine of the grand vin Chateau Margaux.

Claret Blend, Pauillac 1^{er} Cru Classe, Château Moutons Rothschild

£1100

Opulent and New World-like in its ripeness and expression with toasty oak underlying the flavours.

Grenache, Clos Mont Blanc Late Harvest, (Catalunya Spain) (375ml) Aromas of dried figs, prunes and black fruit jam are followed by spicy red fruits on the palate. Well rounded, with great balance and a really long finish	£6	£36
Furmint, 2000 Aszu 3 Grand Tokaji (Hungary) (375ml) Tokaji Aszu 2000 is produced by Crown Estates, the leading Hungarian dessert wine producer. A rich, honeyed dessert wine balanced with refreshing acidity, made using wine-making techniques dating back to 1631.	£7.5	£45
2008 Neige Winter Harvest Ice-Cider (Canada) (375ml) Neige Premiere 2008 is a light orange with coppery reflections in colour. Blend of Fuji, Pouliot, Golden Russet, Cortland, McMillan, Honey Gold and other traditional apple varieties that do not fall from the trees during autumn. These were picked while the temperature was approximately -15°C, the fruits still hanging on trees were dehydrated by the sun and literally cooked by the cold and wind.	£8	£50
Macabeu, Domaine de Rancy Rivesaltes Vin Doux (France) (750ml) Produced by Domaine de Rancy in Rivesaltes, this sweet Rivesaltes Ambre 4 Ans d'Âge is crafted from Grenache and Macabeu, showcasing the region's sun-drenched terroir and commitment to traditional methods. Its exceptional quality is achieved through extended aging in oak, resulting in a rich, complex dessert wine that beautifully expresses the unique characteristics of the terroir.	£9.5	£60
